

# Noel Hanger

*A stunningly simple project and ideal for those last minute preparations, so effective yet so easy to make.*

Click on the buttons above to watch the video, print out the instructions worksheet, print out the templates and buy the materials needed for this project.

You will need 2x A4 cards of two colours for the letters and squares and 4x A4 cards for the background rectangles, plus ribbon and foam pads.

- 1 Print out the letters on the template and cut out.
- 2 Mark out the letters in reverse on the back of the coloured card (turning the letters round so that when they are cut out they read the right way). Use alternate colours, i.e. the 'N' and the 'E' are one colour and the 'O' and the 'L' are the other colour.
- 3 Cut out 4x 13cm squares, two of each colour. Mount the letters with double-sided foam onto the card, alternating the colours.
- 4 Cut out 4x rectangles at 16cm x 17cm for the backgrounds.
- 5 Using a hole punch, punch two holes in exactly the same place on both sides of the 16cm sides of the card. This is to thread the ribbon through. If you don't have a hole punch then you can cut slits.
- 6 Mount the lettered squares onto the backing card with double-sided foam pads, making sure the holes are at the top and bottom if you are hanging the word vertically, or to the side if you are hanging horizontally.
- 7 Thread your ribbon through the holes. Once you're happy with the way it's hanging, fix with double-sided tape at the back between the card and ribbon, keeping it neat and tidy.
- 8 You can add decoration to the letters & tassels to the bottom if you wish.

For an alternative look, you could cut diamonds instead of squares but you will need to adjust the sizes to take the letters or just let them overlap.
